I have been a board director of a number of UK and international architectural and design organisations (including my own) for over 30 years. This means that I understand the roles and duties of a board director and the financial impact of decision making. I have been part of the reestablished Garden Committee for the last year, which has been useful. We first came here just over two years ago and were immediately taken by the uniqueness of the place: the way the gardens and the architecture merge together in a secret central london location. It was clearly managed well, unlike many of the other places we had seen. This is something we value and want to see maintained and improved. We want to be part of this community.

- SGF is an incredibly special place. Over 50 years old, it has matured brilliantly. With my background my primary objectives as a director would be to:

- Develop a long-term strategy for the gardens to ensure that they are fit for the next 50 years: SGL is now our main home, but we have had our own 2-acre garden for many years and understand many of the issues: what works and probably more importantly, what does not.
- Help improve security and safety issues.
- Help to manage the finances to keep an eye on 'improvement strategies' to make infrastructure changes only for technical or safety reasons. We all want to minimise our expenditure.
